



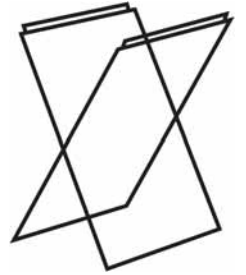
How To Use The ClearStream™ Recyclers

HOW TO SET UP FRAME AND INSERT A BAG

1. Open the frame so it stands up by itself - the end with the extra "loops" goes up.
2. Shake open a bag. Hold it inside the opened frame and put one side of the top of the bag through the loop, from inside to out.
3. Using two hands, pull the edge of the bag up over the over the top of the loop and back toward the inside, wrapping it securely around the corners of the frame.
4. Adjust the bag by pulling down and in, until you feel resistance. The bag will tighten around the loop.
5. Pull the frame closed a couple of inches and then repeat steps 2 & 3 on the other side of the frame.
6. Open the frame all the way and put the plastic lid on the frame. Depending on the size of the bag you use, there may be a bit of slack on the sides that you may have to adjust.

HOW TO REMOVE A BAG...No lifting required!

1. Take off the lid.
2. Pull top pieces of the frame slightly toward each other to give yourself some slack in the bag.
3. Unwrap the bag from the top loops.
4. Holding the bag upright, just slide it out of the frame sideways. **No lifting required!**



RECYCLING CONTAINERS ARE MOST EFFECTIVE WHEN THEY ARE PLACED NEXT TO A TRASH CAN

- People will more likely throw recyclables into trash cans that do not have a recycling container near them.
- Whenever possible, pair up your recycling container with a trash can.
- While the ClearStream Recycler's clear bag and small openings encourage proper use, recycling containers that are located alone are more likely to collect trash and other contaminants than one located next to a trash can.

SOME THINGS TO CONSIDER WHEN PLANNING AN EVENT:

- How many different kinds of beverage containers will be used at the event? Consider limiting containers to plastic only or plastic and aluminum only.
- Where will you take your recycled materials after the event is over? Please check with your local recycling center about their ability to accept your recyclables. You may need to separate plastic bottles from aluminum cans.
- Local scout, sports or environmental groups may be willing to take and separate materials in exchange for the materials. A local civic group or school may use aluminum cans recycling for fund-raising. Consider checking with them, when planning an event.
